

KRI Aquarian Teacher Training Program

“Special Guest Teachers” as part of Level One Training Programs (other than Anatomy & Physiology Specialists)

1. A Lead Trainer may invite a “Special Guest teacher” to participate in his/her Level One Training Program in order to provide the students with the Special Guest’s unique experience or particular expertise in regard to one of the curriculum topics.
2. Special Guest Teacher must be a level 1 KRI certified Instructor of Kundalini Yoga as taught by Yogi Bhajan in good standing.
3. Any Special Guest single segment should be no more than two hours.
4. There should be no more than a total of six hours delivered by Special Guest Teachers in any one Level One program.
5. A member of the Trainer Team (Associate, Professional or Lead level) should introduce the Special Guest, observe the presentation and be available in case there are student questions that the Special Guest cannot answer.
6. The Lead Trainer should be sure that the Special Guest is properly briefed about how the subject matter is presented and integrated in the Level One Program Curriculum, and what specific aspects of this subject the Special Guest should cover.
7. Special Guests may NOT be listed in the contract as part of the Trainer Team.
8. Special Guests may be mentioned in the PR, but not in the section where members of the Trainer Team are listed.
9. Special Guests should be given Confidential Evaluation by the students.
10. Special Guests must read, understand and agree to abide by the KRI Code of Ethics and Professional Standards, both in the classroom and in any subsequent contact they may have with any of the students of a program in which the Special Guest has participated.
