Notes from Lead & Professional Break Out Group

- Filling the competencies and IDP is a challenge for the mentees.
- Suggestion: competencies be worked between the mentees and mentors together. This opens up the opportunity for in-depth resources.
- There is a cultural resistance for self-evaluation and providing feedback.
- Encourage feedback from all participants on the teaching team and have a support system to supervise content credits and competencies.
- Alternatives to organize Level Two: 1) join courses; 2) coordinate course topics across time to not repeat same courses
- The group discussed how to grow sense of community.
- Suggestion: adopt European model that has “corporations”
- Suggestion: Facilitating 21 Stages course or L3 Mela to encourage participation.
- IKYTA may be used as a resource for establishing or creating community space.
- Discussion led into proposed 3HO Yoga Festival, which has been approved; however there needs to be a commitment from Mexico community; a board of members must be agreed upon.
- Group voted to form a board to see through Yoga festival. Members are Gurujodha Singh, Guru Darshan Kaur, Sat Kaur (possibly), Vir Singh, and Raj Bir Kaur
