Would like more structure on how to teach, and how to give an experience and really penetrate. Sharing on technique would be great - how to teach better. Co-teaching was been tricky and challenging. What about bringing in more material into a L1 than is in the manual? Info and kriyas from L2 or from outside YB's teachings? Students are coming in different than before - far higher level than before (though some are the most spiritual, but the weakest physically and no navel point). Keep student focus, not focused on sharing what you're inspired by. Keep it on what will make the students the best teachers. KRI to share more best practices. Make sure everyone is bowing to the teachings, not to the lead trainer. KRI cannot handle the growth now. KY is exploding. Example - is it ok to play music during sadhana (outside of any perscribed music specified in an exercises)? Some way to check up on teachers who are out there teaching - what are they do, how are they doing it. Maybe make them take their 20 classes after the training, not during. Then they can really appreciate and notice the teaching styles.
