MENTORING LEAD PATHWAY (2017)

PROCESS OUTLINE

- Prerequisites
 - Successfully completed two Level One programs as contracting Lead Trainer. (Met all program standards and fulfilled all contractual administrative, financial and certification requirements.)
 - Participation on a Professional / Lead Trainer interview team.
 - Agreement from a KRI approved Mentoring Lead to support candidate during the trial period and give evaluation and recommendation at end of trial period. Peer Mentor needs to complete “Mentoring Lead Recommendation Form” before trial period begins. A Peer mentor cannot be a spouse or other close relationship.
 - A mentee who meets KRI applicant qualifications. (A candidate may have up to two mentees during Trial Period.)
- Formal Application & \$108 Application Fee – (Must submit application before Initial Orientation and Initial Trail Period begins)
- One year Trail Period (minimum)
 - Demonstrate necessary mentoring methodology
 - Demonstrate proficiency in utilizing TnT training tools (Trainer Competencies, Units of Study, IDP, Mentor/Mentee Operating Agreement)
- At end of Trial Period
 - Mentee Feedback Report
 - Peer Mentor Feedback Report
- To begin and end Trial Period, KRI will organize a Mentoring Lead Candidate Meeting during a Forum, Solstice, Yoga Festival, etc.
 - Participating in the Meeting will be:
 - All Initial and Follow up Mentoring Lead Candidates.
 - Peer Mentors (when possible).
 - A Mentoring Lead Interview Team (as determined by the Executive Director)
 - The Executive Director or his representative (focalizer)
 - Initial Candidates will receive Orientation and get sign off to begin Trial Period
 - Follow Up Candidates will
 - Present “Case Study”
 - Following the Case Study presentations, the Interview Team will meet shortly with each Follow Up Candidate and make their recommendation.
- The Interview Report will be presented to the Certification Committee for final approval.
